## Free Tax Preparation Service Gives Retirees Peace of Mind

For Sandy and Ron of Dillsburg, visiting the Bosler Memorial Library in Carlisle during tax season has become an annual tradition. The site offers free tax preparation services through United Way of the Capital Region's Money In Your Pocket (MIYP) program.

"My sister recommended this program several years ago," Sandy says. "Every year, we come back."

For the retired couple, the high quality and friendly service helps make tax season a breeze. Sandy used to prepare their taxes. Changes to the filing process have made her uneasy and concerned about making a mistake. She feels confident in her tax preparer as well as the entire volunteer team.

"The same tax preparer is helping us again this year," Sandy adds. "I encourage everyone to use this service."

MIYP is a community collaboration of organizations committed to the economic stability of local families. The program aims to increase use of the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) and the Child Tax Credit (CTC). The EITC is a tax credit offered by the federal government to supplement wages for low-income workers.

The program receives financial support from High Foundation, PNC, Truist Bank and the U.S. Department of Treasury, Internal Revenue Service.
